

Moricetown RV Park and Campground Billing/Payment/Change or Cancellation Policy

- 1. All reservations require a valid credit card number
- 2. We accept VISA and MASTERCARD, Debit card and cash payments. No personal cheques.
- 3. We allow 2 adults, 2 children and 1 accessible person per site. Additional overnight guests are \$3 per person/per night.
- 4. Booking received one month, or more in advance receive a 10% discount.
- 5. Stay a week and save 10%; stay a month and save 15%
- 6. We require 24 hours' notice for cancellation or changes; cancellation fee of \$20 applies.
- 7. The office has recreational equipment available for free use to campers: soccer ball, volleyball, bocce ball set, badminton set, and children's games on a first come/first serve basis. A \$20 refundable fee with credit card is required prior to using the equipment to ensure it is returned in good order.
- 8. We have a new laundry room with front load steam, energy efficient washers and dryers that are free to use for campers only.
- 9. Exclusive use of the picnic shelter (24 ft x 32 ft) requires a valid credit card and \$50 per night payment. A refundable damage deposit of \$200 applies and is returned if left in good condition.
- 10. For the launch of our Grand Opening 2018 season, we are providing a coupon for 1 free Witsuwit'en Cultural Tour per site (value \$10). Professional Witsuwit'en Culture guides provide group tours at 10:00 am and 2:00 pm daily through the Widzin Kwah Canyon House Museum.
- 11. Daily fishing permits for campers are \$10 per day; non-campers \$15 per day.

Rules and Regulations:

Check In: 2:00 PM Check Out Time: 11:00 AM

Gate Closure and Quiet Time: 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM

Noise: Remember that in the wilderness, sound travels. Respect other guests. Music is to be kept at a reasonable level at all times and turned off at 11:00 PM.

Security: We have an onsite caretaker 24/7 for security. Quiet time will be strictly observed. Guests are responsible for the behavior of everyone on their site.

Pets: Pets are welcome but must not be left unattended at site. Please keep your pet on a leash and pick up after your pet. There are doggie bags available at the office.

Site Occupancy: 2 adults, 2 children and 1 handicapped individual per site, plus one vehicle and one camping unit.

Speed Limit: 10km/hour. Watch for children running. Speed limits are strictly observed.

Recycling and Garbage: There is a Recycling Station and Garbage bins on the grounds. We ask that you leave your site as you found it.

Fishing Permits: Witset is on traditional Laksilyu Territory; fishing within our boundaries is reserved for Witsuwit'en community members. Fishing permits from the Office may be purchased for those wanting to fish for salmon on a daily and weekly basis.

Firewood: The first load of firewood is free; subsequent loads are \$5 each.

Alcoholic Beverages: Moderate drinking is permitted on your campsite. Excessive drinking and partying is not permitted.
